Items You Might Not Know

** Grass Clippings / Yard Waste — Grass clippings & Yard Waste (anything rake able) left by the street for pickup need to be placed in biodegradable bags or in a container that is easily emptied.

** Fall Leaf Pickup — Please refrain from putting brush out during leaf pickup. If necessary it must be piled separately. Leaf pickup date scheduled for Monday-Friday. During fall leaf pickup grass clippings may be mixed with the leaves. Watch the local business in Early to Mid September for notices on when brush pickup will stop.

** Please be careful at the **Recycling Units** — Make sure you place the correct items in the correct bins. If wrong the entire bin goes to the landfill.
