Village is adding a new Call Notification System

This will be used for some emergency notifications. A form is enclosed with the water bill requesting your information so it can be added to the system. Please only add those numbers that are needed. We have to pay for each and every call. It is your responsibility to contact the Village for any contact information changes. If you can't find the document it is also located on the Village website. It can be returned with your water bill, mailed to village or dropped in the drop box outside the Village office.

Items You Might Not Know



**** Grass Clippings / Yard Waste**
 — Grass clippings & Yard Waste (anything rake able) left by the street for pickup need to be placed in biodegradable bags or in a container that is easily emptied.

**** Fall Leaf Pickup** — Please refrain from putting brush out during leaf pickup. If necessary it must be piled separately. Leaf pickup date scheduled for Monday-Friday. During fall leaf pickup grass clippings may be mixed with the leaves.

Watch the local business in Early to Mid September for notices on when brush pickup will stop.

**** Please be careful at the Recycling Units** — Make sure you place the correct items in the correct bins. If wrong the entire bin goes to the land-fill.

**** ** Property Taxes** are being mailed out. You may mail payments, place them in the drop box outside the Village Office or come to the office at one of the scheduled times (Aug 12th and Sep 10th 6:30-7:30 pm & Sep 16th (9am-Noon & 1-6 pm). 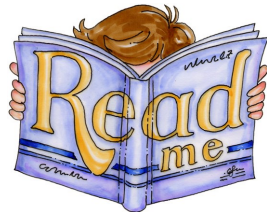
