**** Grass Clippings / Yard Waste**
 — Grass clippings & Yard Waste (anything rake able) left by the street for pickup need to be placed in biodegradable bags or in a container that is easily emptied.

**** Fall Leaf Pickup** — Please refrain from putting brush out during leaf pickup. If necessary it must be piled separately. Leaf pickup date scheduled for Monday-Friday. During fall leaf pickup grass clippings may be mixed with the leaves.

**** Please be careful at the Recycling Units** — Make sure you place the correct items in the correct bins. If wrong the entire bin goes to the land-fill.

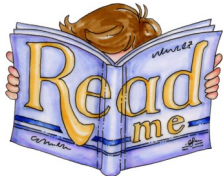
