

The Village of Maple Rapids offers Brush and Leaf Pickup Service. PLEASE DO NOT BURN THESE ITEMS WITHIN THE VILLAGE LIMITS. There are a few request to make the entire process work smoothly.

Brush Pickup is scheduled for each Wednesday. If you put out grass clippings they either must be in a biodegradable bag or in a container that is easily emptied. Please do not overload these bags and containers the Village DPW

reserves the right to not pickup any items that are deemed excessively heavy.

Leaf pickup season is coming upon us. Please refrain from putting brush out during leaf pickup. Brush pickup is set to end in early October.

If you must put some brush out it must be piled separately.

Also grass clippings may be mixed in with the leaves during leaf pickup. This is all in an effort to be more efficient.
